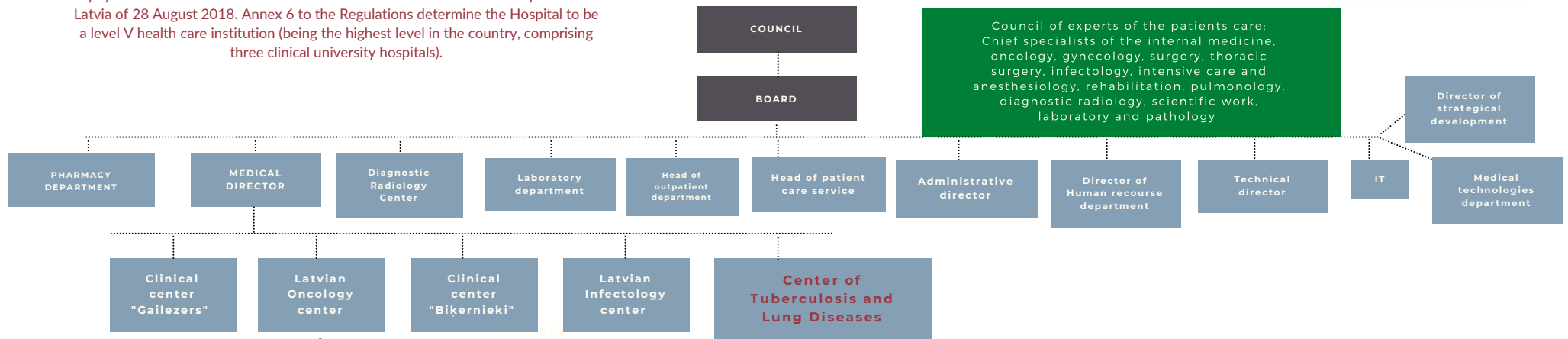


Riga East University hospital is 100% owned by the **Republic of Latvia - the holder of capital shares is the Ministry of Health of the Republic of Latvia**. The Hospital, being a capital company of a public person, acts under the national Law on Governance of Capital Shares of a Public Person and Capital Companies. The health care services provided by the Hospital and paid by the state is determined under the Regulations No. 555 "Procedure for organization and payment of health care services" of the Cabinet of Ministers of the Republic of Latvia of 28 August 2018. Annex 6 to the Regulations determine the Hospital to be a level V health care institution (being the highest level in the country, comprising three clinical university hospitals).
